Cake topper ingredients

Ingredients: Modified Starch (E1422, E1412), Sugar, Maltodextrin, Glucose, Water, Vegitable Oil (Coconut), Glycerol (E422), Gelling Agent, Xantham Gum (E415), Stabilisers (E414, E460i), Emulsifiers (E435), Food Colouring (E171), Flavorings (Vanilla), Preservatives (E202, E330), Humectant, Glycerin, Ethanol, E422, E151 (2.5%), E110* (0.8%), E102*, E330, E122* (2.2%), E202, E133 (2%).

Cupcake ingredients

Light fluffy sponges decorated with plain, lemon or strawberry flavour icing

INGREDIENTS: Wheat Flour (Wheat Flour, Calcium Carbonate, Iron, Niacin, Thiamin), Sugar, Icing (18%) (Sugar, Palm Oil, Dried Glucose Syrup, Glucose Syrup, Dried Skimmed Milk, Emulsifier (Sucrose Esters of Fatty Acids), Preservative (Potassium Sorbate), Gelling Agent (Pectin), Colours (Lutein, Beetroot Red), Flavouring), Rapeseed Oil, Egg, Egg White, Humectant (Glycerol), Raising Agents (Disodium Diphosphate, Potassium Bicarbonate, Calcium Lactate), Wheat Starch, Acidity Regulator (Citric Acid, Potassium Hydroxide), Preservative (Potassium Sorbate), Emulsifiers (Polyglycerol Esters of Fatty Acids, Mono- and Di-Glycerides of Fatty Acids), Flavouring.
