What a mix of weather we have had this week! Spring has well and truly arrived in our playground.


You will have seen on the news that there are two further teacher strike days. We will let you know on Monday if any of our staff will be on strike next Thursday.

We all use the maths skills we were taught at school every day.






#### We are ALL mathematicians.
