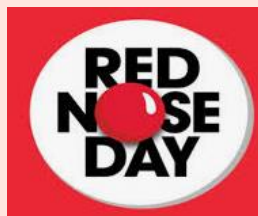

What a day!

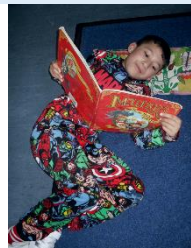
Each class had a 'Booknic' delivered to their classroom which included new books to enjoy, a £1 book token for each child and a book quiz.

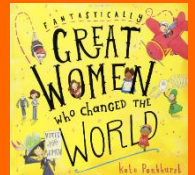
